

WHAT IS THE GOAL?

The strategic opportunity to see a God-exalting, gospel-centered, Biblically-oriented church developed in Brazil is a massive undertaking. This emerging body of believers is currently not able to fully support a full-time pastor on their own. This partnership will allow the church to have trained, mature pastoral leadership during this critical phase of development. Like many church planters/revitalizers, the Souzas will raise financial support for their salary costs and ministry expenses. The goal of this partnership between Bethlehem Baptist, Briarwood Presbyterian, Comunidade Horizonte, and Campus Outreach is to see the church grow to being self-sustaining and multiplying. The Souzas financial support from the US will be received, processed and sent to Brazil by Campus Outreach Ministries in Birmingham, AL.

The Campus Outreach Financial Office will track your giving and send you a receipt after each gift. WHY COMUNIDADE HORIZONTE?

Comunidade Horizonte (Horizon Community Church) is a church that seeks to live, share and teach a God-exalting theology focused on the gospel of grace of our Lord Jesus. CH began in 2007 in the midst of Belo Horizonte, Brazil; the state capital with a population of over 5.1 million in the greater metro area. Although much gospel work has been done in Brazil among the poor, our target groups are the growing numbers of non-religious people in the city with a special focus on the next generation of young people and young families. Over the past several years, God has been gracious to bring people to salvation in Christ and many have reached their own family members and friends. However, the challenge before us to help this core of young believers mature and multiply into a self-sustaining church that influences the city and country for Christ. We see clearly how Jesus' assessment of our situation is true – "the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few". We are excited about and committed to being a part of God's solution to this crisis...being laborers and building laborers that reflect His great love to the world.
